2029 tonnes of limestone applied by air

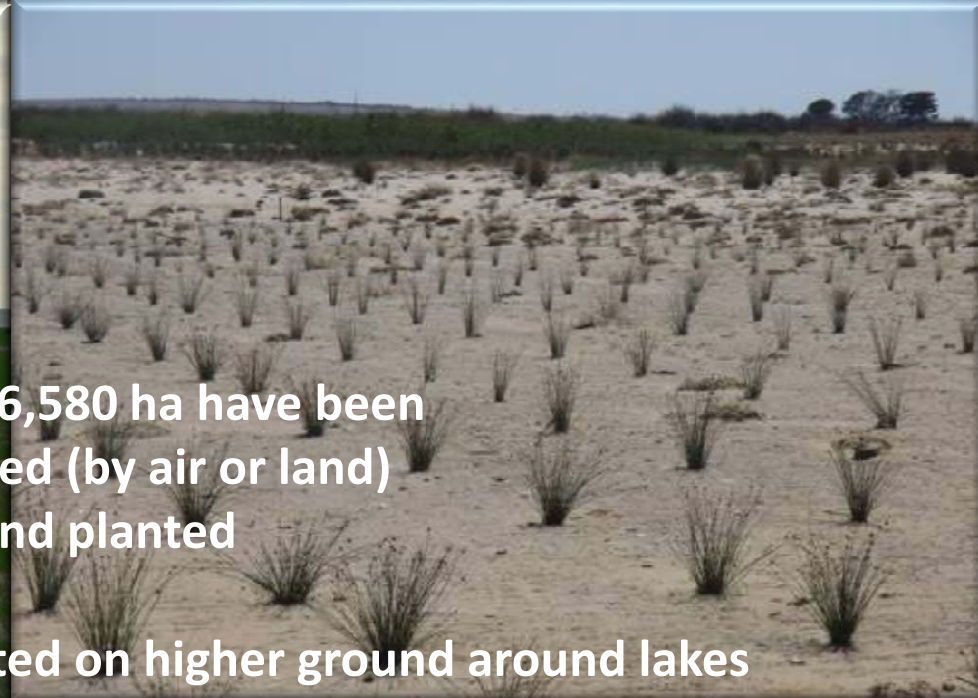


1978 tonnes of limestone applied as barriers



Approximately 6,580 ha have been machine seeded (by air or land) and hand planted

Another 130,000 seedlings were planted on higher ground around lakes



31. LRMIA Acid Drainage

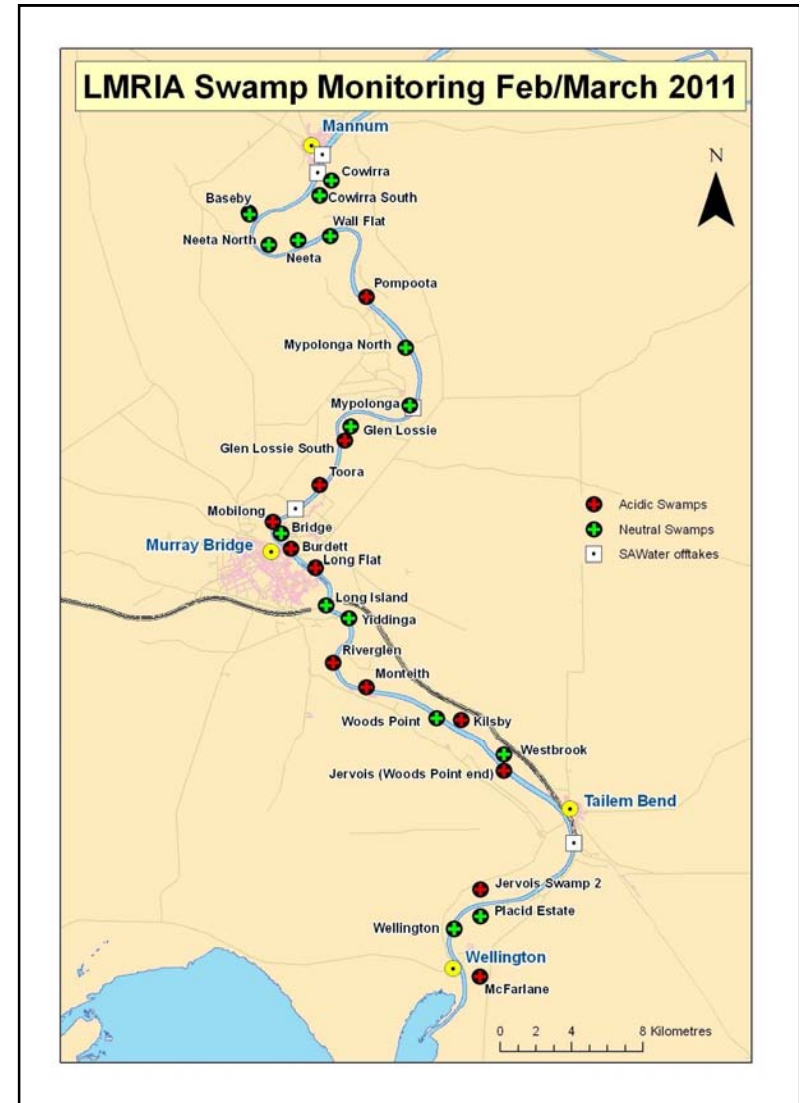
Multi-agency working group established to investigate the cause, and develop management solutions (EPA, DFW, SA Water, SA Health, PIRSA, and SAMDB NRM Board) - meets weekly.

Currently the principle impacts and risks are on-farm, not in the River Channel.

EPA implemented a fast-tracked program of technical investigations to determine the extent and severity of the problem and to develop on-farm management solutions.

13 salt drains now confirmed as acidic pH 2 – 4.

Presence of toxic metals confirmed (Al, Mn, etc).
